

Brighton Doll Festival /Joy of Reborn Dolls Show

*Competition Rules

- ◆ Dolls must be entirely the work of the entrant. All dolls and accessories must be firmly secured for display.
- ◆ Please write your name and address and entry number on a small piece of paper, fold it and secure it with a safety pin somewhere on the doll so that it may not be seen. This helps us to identify a doll should the entry tag become detached.
- ◆ Standing dolls must be on a secure stand, sitting dolls may be displayed in a chair of suitable size for the doll, baby dolls may be displayed on a suitable cradle stand or blanket or pillow, small moses baskets are allowed - no prams, cots or cradles please, we will be limited on space.
- ◆ **Dolls must be handed in at the Registration desk on Sunday 11th April 8.00am-9.30am. Dolls cannot be entered after this time.**
- ◆ **Dolls may only be entered by Vendors who have paid for their stand space**
- ◆ Dolls cannot be collected until after 4.00pm on Sunday 11th April. No exceptions to this rule will be allowed. You must bring your receipt with you to collect your doll. This will be given to you at time of registration.
- ◆ All entries must be pre-registered and paid for before 11th April 2009
- ◆ Entrants should write their entry number on all documentation with the doll.
- ◆ Every care will be taken with your dolls, however, the entrant by registering their entry waives all responsibility from the organisers, her agents or representatives for any loss or damage to your dolls how so ever caused.
- ◆ **Dolls must be entered in person by paying vendors to the Brighton Doll Festival /Joy of Reborn Dolls Show 2010. No mail in and no dolls sent with another person will be permitted**
- ◆ **Entries will be judged by the public, all entries will be anonymous, please make sure that your doll is not identifiable from the outside. Please do not post pictures of your entry on the forums or circulate in any other manner. Any entry found to have been publicly displayed prior to the show will be disqualified.** This will ensure that the voting is fair and based on what the public see. In the event of a tie a suitable person will be appointed by the Organiser to make the final decision. The judge's decision will be final and no correspondence or dialogue will be entered into regarding this decision.
- ◆ A trophy will be awarded to the overall winner plus 2 runner up rosettes. There will also be an award for the best 'Winter Wonderland' themed doll entered in the competition.
